

Special Note for Parents of 11th Grade Students

The Michigan Merit Exam is important for both your student and the school district. Assessment results can be used for college entrance exam purposes and also may qualify your student for scholarship money. It is critical that you avoid scheduling appointments on days of the assessment window.

We are working to provide the best possible testing environment. There will be only one opportunity to make-up any portion of the assessment. Make-up dates will take place March 19, 20 and 21. Approximately two weeks prior to the test, all 11th grade students will receive a letter that details information regarding testing locations, transportation, food service options, and required and prohibited testing materials.
